NOTES

1. In view of the complexity of the flight, train and bus arrangements, it is unlikely to change the date and time of travels once you have confirmed your choice of options, and once tickets are issued.
2. Flight availability may be subject to weather conditions and other conditions beyond our control.
3. There are limited seats available for each option. Availability will be on first-come-first-served basis.
4. Non-refundable portion of the registration is fixed at USD800 for options A-C, and USD300 for options D-E, which will be used for defraying organisational expenses,
5. as well as cancellation fee charged by airlines, railway company and bus rental.
6. Depending on vehicle type, each vehicle will accommodate 4-9 registrants. Coach/bus will accommodate 30 registrants.
7. Please make sure that the email/postal address you share is correct, as we will be sending out updates from time to time, and towards the actual date of travelling, we will be sending out registration package to your email/postal address.

WHERE TO SEND YOUR REGISTRATION FORM

You can send in your registration form by email, fax or snail mail to the following Registration Centre or to the respective Drukpa Centres. Do note that availability of options is on first-come-first-served basis. The form must be sent in with (1) **a copy of your passport** and (2) **a colour passport size photo (2x2 inches or 51x51 mm)** for making of registration ID. All Drukpa Centres are encouraged to group your registrants and send them together in batches, so that accommodation and transportation can be arranged accordingly.
